Activities

- The event doesn't operate without leaders helping with activities We need all the support to ensure we can put the activities on
- Jobshop is on the booking site where leaders can sign up to activities.
 - This is not an exhaustive list, and we'll need support with other area over the weekend i.e. car park, washing up etc
- There will be two meetings over the weekend for leaders, mainly to go over activities, but other updates will be provided where necessary.
 - These will be Friday night (9pm) and Saturday before dinner (6pm)

Departure


This will be from 1pm and with all Explorers off site by 2pm

- The blue and white square in the centre indicates the Check In Hub.






Catering

- Below is the planned menu for the weekend
- Friday supper
 - Chilli
- Breakfast (Saturday & Sunday)
 - Full English and cereals
 - Leaders will be able to get breakfast from 8.30am (this enables leaders to have time to setup activities while Explorers have breakfast) and Explorers at 9am
- Lunch (Saturday & Sunday)
 - Rolls, crisps, chocolate and fruit
- Dinner (Saturday)
